## Instructions:

- 1. Filing deadline is two (2) business days after arrest.
- 2. Narcotics Analysis Unit analyzes one (1) item per charge, unless special circumstances exist. If requesting multiple items to be analyzed, provide justification (see above).
- 3. When the items are all the same narcotic, the one with the greatest weight will be tested unless there is a sales charge.
- 4. The following do not meet minimum filing requirements and will not be processed by NAU:
  - a. An item consisting of less than 6 intact pills.
  - b. Syringes containing less than 0.3 mL of liquid/fluid or syringes that cannot be handled safely.
  - c. Solids with a net weight of less than 0.023 grams.
  - d. Plant material (cannabis) with a net weight of less than 28.5 grams (1 oz.).
  - e. Concentrated cannabis with a net weight of less than 8.0 grams.
  - f. Items containing only residue (e.g., pipes).
