DESTRUCTION OF OBSOLETE ORIGINAL RECORDS

The Department is committed to upholding the right of the public to access records and information concerning the conduct of the people's business consistent with the Constitution of the State of California and the California Public Records Act (CPRA). The Department recognizes its obligation to comply with the CPRA, to facilitate public records access, and to promote a culture of transparency and accountability.

Under new amendments to California law, enacted under Senate Bill (SB) 1421, regarding police officer personnel records and serious Use of Force incidents, specified records and disciplinary actions are now subject to disclosure under the CPRA. In the interest of preserving historical records and further expanding the Department's commitment to transparency, the Department shall not destroy personnel records or Use of Force investigations that are subject to disclosure under SB 1421.
