On Sunday, June 30, 2019, at 0900 hours, the San Francisco Pride Parade will be held in the City of San Francisco, California.

This year, the Department received an invitation from Chief William Scott, San Francisco Police Department, and the San Francisco Police Officer's Pride Alliance for Los Angeles Police Officers to walk in the San Francisco Pride Parade. The San Francisco Pride Parade has been an event for decades that attracts millions of spectators from around the world every year. A strong showing by law enforcement on such a public stage will show our diversity and encourage members of the LGBTQ community to pursue law enforcement careers.

In keeping with past practices at similar events and as deployment will allow, commanding officers are requested to allow officers the opportunity to participate in this event on an off-duty basis. Officers have the option to wear either their Class "A" or Class "C" uniform, no hats or batons.
