**SUBJECT:** DEPARTMENT REORGANIZATION – COMMAND CHANGES

On July 18, 2018, I announced the reorganization of several commands and the renaming of several groups, divisions and sections. Accordingly, the following name changes shall be reflected in the Department Manual and other appropriate documents. Outlined below are the current command changes:

**Office of the Chief of Police.** New command changes under the Office of the Chief of Police (OCOP):

- Community Relations Section has been activated under the OCOP.

**Office of Special Operations.** New command changes under the Office of Special Operations (OSO):

- Community Policing and Policy Group is deactivated and the new Community Engagement Group (CEG) has been activated under OSO.
  - Community Relations Division has been renamed Community Outreach and Development Division (CODD) and relocated under CEG.
- Transit Services Bureau (TSB) has been relocated under OSO.
  - A new Transit Services Group (TRSG) has been activated under TSB.
    - Transit Services Division has been activated under TRSG.
  - A new Traffic Group (TRFG) has been activated under TSB.
    - Central, South, West and Valley Traffic Divisions have been relocated under TRFG.
- A new Counter Terrorism Group (CTG) has been activated under Counter-Terrorism and Special Operations Bureau (CTSOB).
- A new Special Operations Group (SOG) has been activated under CTSOB.
  - Security Services Division has been relocated under SOG.

**Office of Administrative Services has been renamed Office of Support Services.** New command changes under the Office of Support Services (OSS):

- Use of Force Review Division has been renamed Critical Incident Review Division (CIRD) and remains under OSS.
- Police Sciences and Training Bureau has been renamed Personnel and Training Bureau (PTB) and is under OSS.

- A new Personnel Group (PG) has been activated under PTB and includes Personnel Division, Recruitment and Employment Division, and Employee Assistance Unit.
- A new Training Group (TG) has been activated under PTB.
  - Training Division has been separated into two divisions, Training Division (TD) and In-Service Training Division (ISTD); both are activated under TG.
- A new Support Services Group (SSG) has been activated and is under Administrative Services Bureau.
  - Custody Services Division and Property Division have been relocated under SSG.

**Office of the Chief of Staff.** New command changes under the Office of the Chief of Staff (COS):

- Public Communications Group and Media Relations Division have relocated under COS.
- Employee Relations Group has relocated under COS.

**Office of Constitutional Policing and Policy.** New command changes under the Office of Constitutional Policing and Policy (OCP):

- OMBUDS Section has been relocated under Special Projects.

**Detective Bureau.** New command changes under Detective Bureau (DB):

- The Chief of Detectives is a direct report to the Chief of Police.
- Information and Technology Bureau has been renamed Information Technology Group (ITG) and has been relocated under DB.
- A new Detective Services Group (DSG) has been activated under DB.
  - Forensic Science Division and Technical Investigation Division have been relocated under DSG.
- COMPSTAT Division has been relocated under DB.
- A new Innovation and Strategic Planning Division (ISPD) has been activated under DB.

**Professional Standards Bureau.** New command changes under Professional Standards Bureau (PSB):

- A new Force Investigation Group (FIG) has been activated under PSB.
- Force Investigation Division remains and shall report to FIG.

**Office of Operations.** New command change under Office of Operations (OO):

- Homeless Coordinator has been relocated from Operations-Central Bureau to a direct report to the Director, OO.
