SUBJECT: DRIVER LICENSE AND IDENTIFICATION CARD RENEWAL DELAYS –
RESCINDED

A previous Notice was published advising Department personnel that the California Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) had encountered an issue with the Driver License and Identification Card Internet Renewal Application and Renewal by Mail. This delay affected driver licenses or identification (DL/ID) cards with an expiration date of January 20, 2019, through March 31, 2019. Accordingly, officers were advised to refrain from citing members of the public who may have been affected by this issue.

The DMV has advised the Department that this technical error has been rectified. Individuals who renewed their DL/ID should have received their new cards and any inquiry via California Law Enforcement Telecommunications System (CLETS) should accurately reflect the current status of an individual's renewal status. As such, the moratorium on citing individuals under this circumstance has been lifted. Officers *may* cite any individual with an expired DL/ID, consistent with the Department's policy, guiding values, and the law.
