- OPERATIONS-SOUTH BUREAU HAD THE LARGEST DECREASE OF 23% (-34) IN HOMICIDES IN 2023 COMPARED TO 2022.



2023 VICTIMS SHOT



- CITYWIDE THERE WAS A DECREASE OF 10% (-127) IN VICTIMS SHOT IN 2023 COMPARED TO 2022;
- OPERATIONS-CENTRAL BUREAU, OPERATIONS-SOUTH BUREAU, AND OPERATIONS-VALLEY BUREAU SAW A REDUCTION IN VICTIMS SHOT IN 2023 COMPARED TO 2022; AND,
- OPERATIONS-CENTRAL BUREAU HAD THE LARGEST DECREASE OF 14% (-65) IN VICTIMS SHOT IN 2023 COMPARED TO 2022.


FLASH ROBBERIES



- THERE HAVE BEEN 137 FLASH ROBBERIES IN 2023;
- THE ORGANIZED RETAIL THEFT TASK FORCE WAS IMPLIMENTED ON AUGUST 21, 2023. IN THE 132 DAYS SINCE THE BEGINNING OF THE TASK FORCE TO THE END OF 2023THERE HAS BEEN A 33% (-22) REDUCTION IN FLASH ROBBERIES COMPARED TO THE 132 DAYS PRIOR TO THE TASKFORCE; AND,
- SINCE AUGUST 21, 2023, THE TASK FORCE HAS CONDUCTED 109 SEARCH WARRANTS, MADE 128 ARRESTS, RECOVERED 15 FIREARMS, AND RECOVERED \$151,000.00 IN PROPERTY.

8,154 FIREARMS SEIZED

The Department identified 1,232, or 15%, of the total firearms seized as "ghost guns." This is 474 fewer than the 1,706 ghost guns identified in 2022, a decrease of 28%.



2023 CITYWIDE ROBBERIES WITH A FIREARM

- CITYWIDE ROBBERIES WITH A FIREARM ARE 14% (-380) WHEN COMPARED TO 2022, HOWEVER COMPARED TO 2019 ROBBERIES WITH A FIREARM ARE 16% (+342); AND,
- YTD, ROBBERIES WITH A FIREARM ACCOUNT FOR 28% OF ALL ROBBERIES CITYWIDE.

2023 MOTOR VEHICLE THEFTS



- CITYWIDE THERE WAS IN INCREASE OF 2% (+558) IN MOTOR VEHICLE THEFTS IN 2023 COMPARED TO 2022;
- OPERATIONS-SOUTH BUREAU WAS THE ONLY BUREAU WITH AN INCREASE WITH 12% (792) IN MOTOR VEHICLE THEFT IN 2023;
- KIA VEHICLES ACCOUNTED FOR 17% OF TOTAL MVT'S IN 2023, 11% OF ALL MVT'S IN 2022 AND ONLY 2% OF ALL MVT'S IN 2019;
- KIA MVT INCREASED 54% (1,559) IN 2023 COMPARED TO 2022 AND INCREASED 1,407% (4,166) COMPARED TO 2019;
- HYUNDAI VEHICLES ACCOUNTED FOR 13% OF TOTAL MVT'S IN 2023, 10% OF ALL MVT'S IN 2022 AND ONLY 6% OF ALL MVT'S IN 2019; AND,
- HYUNDAI MVT INCREASED 34% (865) IN 2023 COMPARED TO 2022 AND INCREASED 1,248% (3,145) COMPARED TO 2019.

2023 THEFTS



- CITYWIDE THERE WAS AN INCREASE OF 16% (+4,856) IN THEFT IN 2023 COMPARED TO 2022;
- ALL BUREAUS SAW INCREASES IN THEFT IN 2023 COMPARED TO 2022; AND,
- OPERATIONS-VALLEY BUREAU HAD THE LARGEST INCREASE OF 19% (+1,516) IN THEFT IN 2023 COMPARED TO 2022.
