Domestic Violence is a tragic part of some intimate relationships. Many feel they are unable to escape it, but it is possible. There are resources available to help you.

At your LAPD Central Police station, we have advocates and officers who have a focus of

helping anyone in a cycle of abuse.

Domestic Abuse can be verbal – (Crimianl threats of serious bodily injury or death) or physical and sexual violence between intimate partners.

Intimate relationships include

- Married
- Divorces
- Dating
- Fomally dating
- Family
- Children in common

It doesn’t matter your sexual orientation. We are here to help anyone escape violence. All we ask is that you work with us. We can provide shelter informstion, advocacy, emergency protective orders and medical treatment if needed. You have the right ot be interviewed by someone of the same sex, to have a friend with you, or an advocate during the process.
