SUBJECT: RELEASE FROM CUSTODY (RFC) – REVISED; AND,

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT BOOKING APPROVAL,

**FORM 12.31.00 – REVISED** 

**PURPOSE**: The purpose of this Order is to revise Department Manual Section 4/216.65,

Release from Custody (RFC), and the Department Booking Approval, Form

12.31.00, consistent with the revisions to California Penal Code (PC) Section 853.6 – Citations for Misdemeanors, and pursuant to California Assembly Bill (AB) 2294. Assembly Bill 2294 amends 853.6 PC to include additional reasons for non-release of arrestees related to "theft from a store" and "organized retail theft," effective January 1, 2023, through January 1, 2026.

#### PROCEDURE:

I. RELEASE FROM CUSTODY (RFC) – REVISED. Department Manual Section 4/216.65, *Release from Custody (RFC)*, has been revised. Attached is the Manual section with the revisions indicated in italics.

II. LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT BOOKING APPROVAL, FORM 12.31.00 – REVISED. The Booking Approval, Form 12.31.00, has been revised and is attached.

**FORM AVAILIBILITY:** The revised Booking Approval form is available in E-Forms on the Department's Local Area Network and is attached for immediate use and duplication. The "Form Use" for this form is unchanged. All other versions of the Booking Approval shall be marked "obsolete" and placed into Area/divisional recycling bins.

**AMENDMENT:** This Order amends Section 4/216.65 of the Department Manual.

**AUDIT RESPONSIBILITY:** The Commanding Officer, Audit Division, shall review this directive and determine whether an audit or inspection shall be conducted in accordance with Department Manual Section 0/080.30.

## DEPARTMENT MANUAL VOLUME IV

#### Revised by Special Order No. 8, 2023

### 216.65 RELEASE FROM CUSTODY (RFC).

**Conditions For Release From Custody.** Each adult **misdemeanor** arrestee shall be released from custody unless one or more of the following conditions exist:

- Arrestee is intoxicated to the point where the arrestee could be a danger to *themself* or others;
- Arrestee requires a medical examination or medical care, or is otherwise unable to care for *their* own safety;
- Arrestee is in custody for a violation of one or more of the circumstances listed in Sections 40302 or 40303 of the *California* Vehicle Code; (*Exception*: Driving under the influence (DUI) arrestees may be released after booking, if otherwise eligible).
- Arrestee has one or more outstanding arrest warrants;
- Arrestee has one or more outstanding misdemeanor arrest warrants not eligible for release under Section 827.1 of the *California* Penal Code (*Department Manual Section* 4/216.67);
- Arrestee is unable to provide satisfactory identification (per Department Manual Section 4/216.66);
- Immediate release of the arrestee would jeopardize the prosecution of the offense for which *they were* arrested or their prosecution for any other *known* offense (i.e., for which probable cause exists);
- There is a reasonable *belief* that the offense *will* continue or resume, or that the safety of a person(s) or property would be imminently endangered by the release of the arrestee;
- Arrestee demands to be taken before a magistrate or refuses to sign the Non-Traffic Notice to Appear, *Form 05.02.02*;
- There is reason to believe that the arrestee would not appear at the time/place specified in the Notice;
- Arrestee has been cited, arrested, or convicted for misdemeanor or felony theft from a store in the previous six months (Pursuant to California Assembly Bill 2294 and effective January 1, 2023, thru January 1, 2026); and,
- There is probable cause to believe the person arrested is guilty of committing organized retail theft, as defined in subdivision (a) of Section 490.4 of the California Penal Code (Pursuant to California Assembly Bill 2294 and effective January 1, 2023, thru January 1, 2026).

When an adult misdemeanor arrestee is not released from custody pursuant to one of the above listed conditions, officers shall articulate the specific circumstances which justify the continued custody in the narrative of the Arrest Report, Form 05.02.00.

**Note:** Traffic-related misdemeanors, except those listed in Section 40302 of the California Vehicle Code, shall be cited using a Traffic Notice to Appear, Form 04.50.00, and the Continuation of Notice to Appear, Form 04.50.05, in lieu of *an* Arrest Report.
