

LAPD BLOCKWISE SUMMARY

Los Angeles, CA LAPD | Central Division Blockwise Survey Executive Summary

Most Recent Cycle: February 1–28, 2026

This executive summary presents key findings from the latest Blockwise Survey for the Central Division of Los Angeles, CA LAPD, covering February 2026. The data reflects resident perceptions across core aspects of police service, with demographic breakdowns highlighting variations in satisfaction.

Insights

- **General Satisfaction:** A majority of Central Division residents reported positive experiences, but notable gaps exist across demographic groups.
 - **Safety Perceptions:** Safety scores are lower than other aspects, with over half of respondents expressing concerns.
 - **Fairness and Respect:** These aspects received moderate to high positive ratings, with higher education and White respondents reporting the highest satisfaction.
 - **Voice:** Residents feel moderately heard, but younger and less-educated groups report lower satisfaction.
 - **Demographic Patterns:** Higher education, White, and male respondents consistently report higher satisfaction across all aspects, while younger, female, and some minority groups report lower scores.
 - **Participation:** 149–147 valid responses per aspect in Central Division for this cycle.
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Key Findings

General Satisfaction:

- 57.8% positive, 17.9% negative, 22.1% neutral (n=149)
- Highest satisfaction: Higher education (82.7%), White (72.9%), Male (68.0%)
- Lowest satisfaction: High school or less (39.1%), Female (43.9%), 18–34 age group (50.5%)

Safety:

- 44.9% positive, 55.1% negative, 0% neutral (n=135)
- Highest satisfaction: Higher education (78.7%), White (65.0%), Male (48.8%)
- Lowest satisfaction: Some college (25.8%), Female (39.9%), 18–34 age group (37.2%)

Fairness:

- 53.3% positive, 27.8% negative, 19.0% neutral (n=148)
- Highest satisfaction: Higher education (74.9%), White (70.1%), Male (61.6%)

- Lowest satisfaction: High school or less (42.6%), Female (41.2%), 18–34 age group (53.4%)

Respect:

- 63.8% positive, 20.9% negative, 15.3% neutral (n=147)
- Highest satisfaction: Higher education (85.4%), White (81.7%), Male (73.0%)
- Lowest satisfaction: High school or less (48.4%), Female (50.4%)

Voice:

- 60.7% positive, 24.3% negative, 13.5% neutral (n=147)
- Highest satisfaction: Higher education (85.9%), White (75.4%), Male (69.1%)

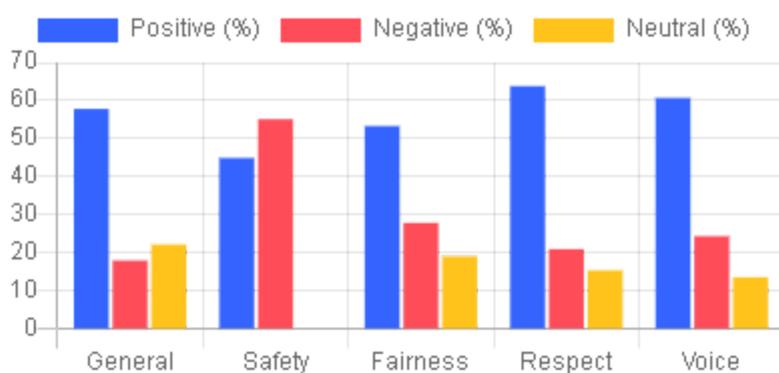
