<p>6:05 – 6:15</p>	<p>Introduction / Updates Crime update: 19% increase in homicides, 4 more than last year, 2 from incidents that occurred last year but victims passed away this year. Sexual Assaults down 21%. Robberies down 6%. Aggravated assaults down 5.6%. Burglaries up 16.8%. Grand Theft Autos down 7.4%. Burglaries from motor vehicles down 2.9%. Overall Theft down 30%. <p>6:15 – 6:30</p>	<p>Operations - South Bureau Grateful of the 77th team & steady decrease in crime. Has been South Bureau Deputy Chief since 2023. 29 years with LAPD and almost all 3 decades working in South LA community. Number one focus is the violent crime in our communities. That violent crime encompasses human trafficking along corridor as well as homicides & shooting victims. YTD we have rescued over 71 young girls ages 11 to 17 years old. Last year we rescued 60. Another priority is addressing organized retail thefts along with street racing and street take overs. Third focus is wellness of officers that work South Bureau.</p>	<p>Emada Tingirides Deputy Chief</p>
