# Los Angeles, CA LAPD | Central Division Blockwise Survey Executive Summary

Cycle: September 1-30, 2025

This executive summary presents resident feedback from the Los Angeles Police Department's Blockwise survey for the Central Division, covering September 2025. The analysis highlights perceptions of safety, fairness, respect, approachability, and police response to protests, based on 3,520 valid survey submissions.

## Insights

#### **Safety Perceptions:**

The majority of residents feel only "somewhat" or "mostly" safe in their neighborhoods, with 15% reporting "not safe" and 38% "somewhat safe." This indicates persistent concerns about crime in the Central Division.

#### **Fairness & Respect:**

Responses show a positive tilt: 52% agree or strongly agree that LAPD treats everyone fairly, and 53% agree or strongly agree that LAPD provides the same quality of service to all. However, 22% remain neutral, and 22% disagree or strongly disagree, suggesting room for improvement in perceived equity.

#### **Approachability & Voice:**

60% of respondents agree or strongly agree that LAPD officers are approachable, and 54% feel officers listen to and consider resident concerns. Willingness to contact LAPD if victimized is high (72% fairly or very willing).

#### **Reporting Crime:**

19% of respondents experienced a crime but did not report it, while 18% did report. The majority (75%) had no incidents to report.

#### **Areas Considered Unsafe:**

60% of respondents identified places in their area as unsafe. The leading reasons are personal experience with crime (52%), followed by information from friends/family (40%) and media reports (38%).

#### **Police Response to Protests:**

Satisfaction with LAPD's response to immigration-related protests is mixed: 30% neutral, 39% dissatisfied, and 32% satisfied. Perceptions of the appropriateness of force used are similarly divided, with 33% neutral, 33% inappropriate, and 32% appropriate.


