Approval of prior meeting minutes –Motion made by Bill, seconded by Georgina, approved as written.

Captain Report- Thank you SLO Office and supervisors doing a great job. Unfortunate that we had to cancel 100th Anniversary, but the weather report was too ominous. It has been rescheduled to February 26 in conjunction with the formal inspection. The new plan will have the Chief of Police, Assistant Chiefs, past Captains of Pacific will be invited. Culver Blvd will be shut down. Bagpipes will be invited to play. It will be scaled down to food afterwards in the parking lot. Yes, volunteers will be needed.

Update: \$250,000 Grant from the Police Foundation will be used to replace the roof on the trailer, remodel roll call room, build a room for the Training Unit. Permission needs to go through City Council before any construction can be done.

Looking forward to Officer Appreciation dinner. Sleigh will be going out 6-7 times. Georgina was recognized for wearing her volunteer patrol uniform.

Thank you for all the support.

Pat requested adding new decking on the front of the trailer to be added to the list of construction requests. Possibly using Trek.

Guest Speaker-SLO Henderson LAX- End of December Tom Bradley terminal will shut down to refresh the ticket counters. Construction is expected to take 2 years.

SLO Reports:

A-11 – Acting SLO Navarrete reported that Rose and Main is recognized as a problem area. He is working with CD #11 scheduling regular clean-ups. Area has regular patrol. Last clean-up 1 person took housing. Tires of vans are chalked, they move, one van cited.

A-13- SLO Madison has been identifying problem areas, such as Rose and 3. Some unhoused are compliant with ADFA rules. He is working with city agencies to address the issues.

Care+ is not closing.

A-25- SLO Ramirez reported on Operation at Beethoven. Recognizes the 45 encampments on private land, working with the owner. It is a big undertaking with 40-60 people affected. 12 people accepted placements. There is 24-hour security. Expect the property to be cleared for a development.

Area near the Ballona Creek is better. Working on Washington and Lincoln. Today Coffee with Cops was held at Whole Foods. It was well attended. Be aware during the holiday season, arrange for packages to be picked up by neighbors or use Amazon lockers.

A-25-SLO Villery thanked SLO Acosta for working with him to clear encampments at McLaughlin and Venice. Thefts have increased in the area. Property crime is down 29%. Unhoused responsible for copper wire theft. 12/2 Penmar was cleaned up with the assistance of other agencies.

A-27- SLO Acosta's area, SLO Villery giving the report. Sepulveda and 10 Freeway are clear. CARE + helped and fencing was put in with the approval of CD #5. Arrests were made by West LA division.

A-67 and 73- Acting SLO Urrea reported that Westchester Parking lot has patrol night and day. La Tijera encampment has been cleaned up. Citizens reporting helps identify areas such as vacant houses, "holiday houses" and suspicious cars.

Santa's Sleigh schedule is complete.

He is scheduled to go on a tour of the new construction at LAX with hotel security officers.
