

DOES YOUR EVENT REQUIRE A POLICE PERMIT?

ONE NIGHT DANCE (ONE DAY EVENT)



CARNIVAL

- Any "carnival event" requires a police permit. A carnival is "any fair, festival, or like activity of a temporary nature having a concession or concessions (any booth or stand that includes any game or test of skill, science or amusement). Some examples are: a circus, festival, or fair.
- If your carnival has live music, you <u>do not</u> need to obtain a one-night dance permit.



RIDES

- Any event that has a mechanical ride (includes merry-go-round, Ferris wheel, carousel, rocket ride, looper ride, roller coaster, dive-ride, or other similar device) requires a police permit.
- If you are having a carnival with rides, you require <u>both</u> the carnival and rides police permit.



An event is considered a **private event* if it is not open to the public, such as a wedding, birthday party, celebration of life, etc.

NOTE: If an event is held at a residence, no police permit is needed.
