Captain III Kelly Muniz Introduction:

- -Captain Muniz has been in central for approx. 1 month and she is focusing on the quality of life issues. Central used to have more resources i.e. bike units, more foot beat officers, special enforcement units, however that is not currently what we are working with.
- -In order to fill those holes we had a budget for overtime to supplement these specialized units. However, NOW, that overtime budget is no longer in place.
- -Central is doing our best to use the command and number of officers that we have. Crime stats are down so we are trying to keep that momentum going.
- -Captain Muniz's goal is to get the business owners, residents and all who come to downtown feel safe. DTLA should be a place where people come from all over to experience the great diversity of restaurants, entertainment, and hospitality that downtown has to offer.
- -It is the job of Central Division to ensure these qualities of life and safety issues.

Senior Lead Officer Updates:

<u>1A1:</u>

- -501 N. Hill st Cleanup removing huge encampments. 928 N main clean up as well.
- -Focus now is on Arcadia and Alameda to implement cleanups in that area.

1A12:

- -Civic Center area continues to have protests, activists, and vandalisms take place in the area. Investigations are taking place to arrests these individuals by detectives.
- -Community members are encouraged to make reports online, so we can see the dots on the map that way central command can get resources to the areas that need it.

1A85:

- -Encampment clean ups continue to take place.
- -Senior Lead Officers are working with Building and safety in order to address vacant building and graffiti concerns.

-Senior Lead Officers have reached out to every apartment building to touch base with the residents in these areas and provided contact information for residents to get a hold of senior lead officers.

1A29:

- -New Senior Lead Officer Christian Costales coming from LAPD Headquarters who is the new partner to Senior Lead Officer Liz Southern for the little Tokyo & arts district.
- -Continuing to educate residents on filing reports online when victims of crime as well as locking and securing vehicles.

1A35:

- -Spring st corridor had a lot of BFMV's so remembering to take your belongings out of your vehicles so that it can help prevent break ins.
- -Aggravated assaults continue to take place within skid row. Senior Lead Officer Joseph will be conducting high visibility and foot beats in these areas.
