

# **COMMUNITY POLICING ADVISORY**

## **BOARD 02/19/2026**

This meeting was at Central Station as well as on Zoom. Start time of approx. 1005 hours.

### **Guest Speaker Officer Cesar Ceballos “Real Time Crime Center”:**

- Unit consists of 1 civilian and 3 officers and central division within this unit.
- These operators are able to monitor surveillance cameras that are installed at businesses, schools, residents and various locations throughout DTLA. These locations are able to limit their video sharing to emergency situations like active shooters, crime incidences, etc.
- When a crime takes place, this allows police officers or detectives to pull the footage immediately, which speeds up the investigation for a more effective outcome in catching the suspects.
- This program goes beyond video, enabling field-based users to transmit their location, send panic alerts, receive image and text alerts, and communicate directly with FUSYS1 via an iOS or Android.
- One of the goals is to continue partnering with the community and having them join this program so law enforcement can have access to their surveillance footage if a crime occurs at their location.
- The real time crime center having access to these cameras at these various locations allows the unit to view the footage LIVE and even SEE suspects live so that patrol units can respond faster and have a live-in real-time description of the suspect/s.

### **Central Crime Updates Captain Kelly Muniz:**

- Crime overall in DTLA has been down in regard to violent crime however the property crimes continue to take place as well as quality of life issues.
- Senior Lead officers have been working within their respected areas and partnering with their community members to take all the precautions and preventative measure to prevent crime in these areas.

### **CD 14 Updates Adam Acosta:**

-Council District will be working with the Neighborhood councils, BIDS, Street Lighting Bureau, and several other entities to make improvements throughout downtown.

-Tree trimming requests will be taking place in the social district, Senior lead officers Padilla and Zambrano were notified to advise the community members in their area.

-Spring st park has also been a priority in trying to get security to monitor the location as well as other measures and resources that will be beneficial to that area. CD 14 has removed the fence.

-Homeless outreach requests will also be made through CD14 where individuals can qualify for resources.

-Fiesta Broadway is coming up & CD 14 will be working with CD9.

### **CD 1 Updates Katie Chan:**

-Cleanups continue to be scheduled through clean teams of “LA Conservation Corps, or KYCC” to clean and maintain Chinatown.

-The Chinatown BID has been discontinued and no longer active at this time beginning Jan 2026.

- Also, the council member heard loud and clear from the residents, business owners, and property owners, and have decided to use discretionary funding to hire GSG Security Services. This is also in light of the bid, not being active anymore in Chinatown.

- And the number to call GSG Security Services is 310-709-7786. This number is not 24/7. If an emergency, call 911. This resource is only serving business corridors, not residential areas.

-Their deployment is 4 guards, 5 days a week. Tuesday to Thursdays, 9am to 5pm. Friday and Saturday is 3 p.m. to 11pm.

### **Senior Lead Officer Updates for Areas 1,21, 29, 41, 56.**

-Clean ups continue to be taking place in all pertinent areas. Senior Lead Officers are continuing to work with CD 14 to assist with these clean ups.

-Be advised to remove any valuables from your car. Lock and secure your vehicle when parking in DTLA. If you must leave important items inside, do not leave them visible.

-Don't leave your keys inside your car. Primary reason for vehicle thefts are when people leave the keys in their vehicle.

-Senior Lead officers continue to conduct foot beats in their areas and high visibility.
