The city attorney heavily emphasized that her team needs concrete evidence to present it further in court. Most of these crimes that take place there is no video, and the suspects have their faces covered with ski masks and are wearing all dark clothing, so law enforcement cannot document even a physical description of the suspects, which cripples the case.
