A group organized an unpermitted concert and trespassed onto private property. The concert was hosted on private property without the owners consent. After confirming that a crime had occurred and the property owner requested enforcement action, a dispersal plan was developed and executed.

Rioters threw rocks, glass bottles and Molotov Cocktails at uniformed officers. Rioters also lit a fire on the rooftop of 1721 S. Trinity Street. High-powered fireworks were also launched at the air unit overhead.

Four officers were injured during this incident.
