Call to Order 1830

Chairperson Raines called the meeting to order.

Roll Call

Roll Call was conducted with Sergeant. Saenz, Captain Jordan, Captain Soliman, Senior Lead Officers, and CPAB Board Members.

Southwest Area Updates – Crime & Significant Incidents 1833

Presented by Southwest Area Captain Jordan

Overall, Person and Property Crimes were discussed. Covering monthly crime and crime year-to-date. Overall crime is down in all categories (23% reduction). Burglaries are up 30%. Increase in arrest year-to-date. Captain also provided updates on the Southwest Cadet Graduation, referenced special event CicLAvia, and Juneteenth. Summer Night Lights Program were also discussed and how they are operating across 4 different parks. Captain Jordan introduced Captain Soliman as the new Patrol Captain for Southwest division.

Special Guest 1840

Special Guest Rhondalynn Pigge Victims' Rights Advocate. Guest speaker discussed the explanation of victims' rights, importance of gathering documentation, and reference the California Victims' Compensation Board.

Types of cases covered: domestic violence, homicide, elder abuse, and hit and runs.

Services discussed: funeral assistance and compensation for medical care. Guest speaker explained that personal property is not covered under compensation and the importance of the program is to provide assistance for victims of crime who cannot cover expenses.

Senior Lead Officer Updates 1856

Sergeant Saenz discussed upcoming community events such as Coffee with a Cop on 7/16 at Target, Coffee with a Cop on 7/23 at Fuegos, and Tip a Cop on 7/23 at Chic Fil A for the Special Olympics. All Senior Lead Officers (SLO) shared their crime updates and community concerns in their assigned Basic Car. SLOs discussed recent crime trends and gave input on significant incidents. Additional resources and community events were shared followed by Q&A.

Public Comment 1930

Meeting attendees had the opportunity to address any community concerns and comments. All participants were limited to a 2-minute time slot to allow an opportunity for all attendees to speak.
