Motorcycle Officer Update Expanded Course Outline

<u>Instructional Goal:</u> To provide the student with an update of basic police motorcycle riding: focusing on safety and proper motorcycle / control manipulation.

<u>Performance Objectives:</u> Students will utilize riding techniques taught in Basic Motorcycle School and will be tested on the Road Course Qualification given in Motorcycle School. The following concepts will be taught:

- Individual safe riding techniques in practice mazes.
- Pair safe riding techniques and control in the Road Course.

<u>Learning Activities:</u> Motorcycle instruction is conducted on a paved area. Continued evaluation for the Basic Rider Skills consists of test of timed Road Course.

Student Assessment: The students are evaluated in established categories and determined to be at a "proficient" or "needs improvement" level.

• Evaluated level of "needs improvement" level will result in the students Commanding Officer being notified as well as scheduled individual training with the Motorcycle Training Unit.
