Community Police Advisory Board (C-PAB)

- 1. Commanding Officer Updates (Captain Ortiz):
 - a. Crimes Statistics Southeast Division
 - Violent crimes have gotten a reduction except for robbery, which saw an increase in number of cases.
 - Property crimes has been a struggle in handing with.
 - 1.2% increase in burglaries.
 - Thefts have occurred more in CVS and WSS retails.
 - a. Most common items taken are diapers, toilet paper, and toothpaste.
 - More proactive policing in communities such as stops.
 - \circ 33 total guns were recovered because of these actions.
 - There has been a total of 336 fatal traffic collisions in the city.
 - Most are caused by speed, distracted and reckless driving.

2. Special Guest

a. Aydin Senkut, SoLa Foundation

- SoLa aims to prevent homelessness and provide affordable housing.
 - In the housing development, 2,000 units have been built with another 1,500 on the way.
 - 80% complete housing on Main and Imperial.
- Another focus of SoLa is the commitment to bring high paying jobs to South Los Angeles.
- Lastly, SoLa aims to provide access to education and opportunities.
 - For example, they provide technology programming skills in their Tech center.
 - It is partnership between SoLa and Riot Games.
- 3. Traffic Statistics

- a. **Officer Roth** (South Traffic Liason)
 - 8% increase in fatalities
 - Caused by street racing and traffic collisions.
 - There has been a total of 179 pedestrian collisions.
 - Traffic enforcement alone isn't enough, for example, the number of tickets given lead to collisions increasing more.
 - Handling these types of cases requires a more proactive approach in terms of educating people about the safety and dangers on the road.
 - Interesting Fact: In Hawaii, it is illegal to use your electronic devices while crossing the streets.
 - The Speed Racing Task Force has been reorganized to help better deal with the continuous problems of speed racing occurring.
 - Car Seat Inspection event will be held this summer.
